Washington, DC (April 8, 2013)—Calling all artists... Tortilla Coast Logan Circle wants help in adding to its vivacious décor! Students and seasoned artists alike are invited to showcase their talents through an original sketch or digital mock-up accompanied by a 300-word maximum description of their work. All are welcome to view the space at 1460 P Street NW for inspiration. Designs will be judged on artistic merit, creativity, and ability to express the local landscape of Logan Circle, the surrounding location or any original idea.

*** Tortilla Coast Logan Circle Mural Contest Rules and Regulations**

1. Entry period

Clover Restaurant Group (CRG) owner of Tortilla Coast Logan Circle will begin accepting submissions on Monday, April 8, 2013. Entries must be received no later than 4 pm Friday, May 31, 2013.

2. Eligibility

The contest is open to all US Citizens or those non-US citizens that can show proof of legal residency status. There is no purchase required to enter the contest. The contest is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations and any aspect of the contest is void to the extent prohibited by law.

3. Rules of Entry

CRG is not responsible for any lost, late, incomplete, invalid, unintelligible, or misdirected entries. Submissions will not be returned and will become the property of CRG. By entering the contest, all parties agree that CRG has the right to display, copy, distribute and otherwise use the artwork as it sees fit without any fee or other form of compensation.

4. Agreement to Rules

By entering the contest, all parties fully and unconditionally agree to and accept the rules as outlined herein and agree to accept the decisions of CRG and of the contest judges, which are final and binding.

5. Judging Criteria

Entries must meet all rules and submission criteria as stated herein to be eligible. Entries will be evaluated by a panel of judges. Artwork will be judged on artistic merit, creativity, and ability to express the local landscape of Logan Circle and the surrounding neighborhood or any original idea.

6. Prizes

The GRAND CHAMPION artwork winner will permanently display their signature on the mural and will receive \$5,000 cash for painting the mural.

7. Publicity

CRG reserves the right to cancel, suspend and/or modify the contest or any part of it or to not pick any winner from the entries. The winning artist agrees to paint/install the winning design at their expense at Tortilla Coast Logan Circle. The sketch should be scaled to the wall which is 18 feet 8 inches wide and 5 feet tall. Installation must be completed within 30 days of the date the winner is announced.
